Guide to Submitting Exhibition Applications

The Kunstraum is a voluntarily led association. Individual events and exhibitions are organized in rotation by the various Kunstraum curators, who typically realize their own exhibition concepts. Therefore, outside applications usually have little chance of success. Unsolicited applications for exhibitions can only be considered if one of the curators takes on the responsibility for the proposed project.

However, we are happy to cooperate on shorter events such as catalogue presentations, film evenings, etc. and are open for suggestions. The best way is through direct personal contact, e.g. on the occasion of an opening.

Should you still want to apply for an exhibition, we kindly ask that you to consider the following in order to keep the processing time within reasonable limits for both you and us:

Please have a look at our current exhibition program and check whether your own artistic work fits into the programmatic orientation of the Kunstraum.

Please make sure that your documents contain representative visual material in the form of printouts, catalogues, as a PDF, or a link to current projects. CD-Rs or other data carriers will not be considered.

Please provide an e-mail address. If you would like to have your documents returned to you by mail, please include sufficient postage and a return envelope. Otherwise, they will remain in the Kunstraum for exactly one month following our reply for unsolicited collection during our exhibition opening hours. Due to space constraints, we do not keep unsolicited catalogues.

Please understand that we only process applications collectively about twice a year and that in some circumstances it may take quite along time to respond to you.
